AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to permitting persons registered to vote but not enrolled in a party to vote in the presidential primary

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1-104 of the election law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 38 to read as follows:
- 3 38. The term "undeclared voter" means a person registered to vote and who is not enrolled in a party pursuant to article five of this chapter.
- § 2. The election law is amended by adding a new section 2-123 to read as follows:
- 7 § 2-123. Open presidential primaries. Notwithstanding any provision of 8 law to the contrary, after the effective date of this section, an unde-9 clared voter shall be permitted to vote in the presidential primary of
- 10 any party. Such undeclared voter may only vote in the presidential
- 11 primary of one party. Such undeclared voter shall select the party in
- 12 which the voter wishes to cast such a ballot on the day of the presiden-
- 13 tial primary at the polling place of the undeclared voter at the time
- 14 such voter seeks to cast a ballot.
- 15 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
