AN ACT to amend the legislative law, in relation to bills with a threshold level of co-sponsorship

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The legislative law is amended by adding a new section 33-a 2 to read as follows:
- § 33-a. Bills with a threshold level of co-sponsorship. 1. Any bill introduced in the assembly shall, upon being co-sponsored by seventy-six or more members, be brought to the floor of the house for a vote to be taken thereon during the legislative session in which it was introduced.
- 7 2. Any bill introduced in the senate shall, upon being co-sponsored by
  8 thirty-two or more members, be brought to the floor of the house for a
  9 vote to be taken thereon during the legislative session in which it was
  10 introduced.
- 11 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-12 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
