AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to the Alzheimer's
detection and education program and mapping of Alzheimer's locations

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assem-
bly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Article 24 of the public health law is amended by adding a
2 new title 1-C to read as follows:

TITLE 1-C

ALZHEIMER'S DETECTION, EDUCATION AND MAPPING PROGRAM

3 Section 2415-a. Alzheimer's detection, education and mapping program;
4 establishment.

2415-b. Annual report.

5 § 2415-a. Alzheimer's detection, education and mapping program; estab-
6 lishment. 1. There is hereby created within the department the
7 Alzheimer's detection, education and mapping program. This program is
8 established to promote screening and detection of Alzheimer's, to
9 educate the public regarding Alzheimer's, to provide counseling and
10 referral services and to map locations of occurrence of Alzheimer's.

2. The program shall include:

11 (a) establishment of a statewide public education and outreach
12 campaign to publicize Alzheimer's detection and education services, such
13 campaign shall include: general community education, Alzheimer's screen-
14 ing services, information on the extent of coverage for such services by
15 health insurance, any available medical assistance program and other
16 public and private programs; and

17 (b) compilation of data concerning the Alzheimer's detection, educa-
18 tion and mapping program including mapping of the frequency of the
19 occurrence of Alzheimer's in various locations in the state and dissem-
20 ination of the data to the public.

21 EXPLANATION--Matter in italics (underscored) is new; matter in brackets
22 [-] is old law to be omitted.

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1 § 2415-b. Annual report. The commissioner shall submit on or before
2 December first, an annual report to the governor and the legislature,
3 concerning the operation of the Alzheimer's detection, education and
4 mapping program. Commencing in two thousand eighteen, such reports shall
5 include the experience of the program in providing detection, education
6 and mapping of the frequency of the occurrence of Alzheimer's in various
7 locations around the state. Approved organizations shall provide such
8 data and assessment as the commissioner may require for such report.
9 Such report shall also include any recommendations for additional action
10 to respond to the high incidence of Alzheimer's in this state.

11 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall
12 have become a law; provided that the commissioner of health is imme-
13 diately authorized and directed to promulgate, amend and/or repeal any
14 rule and regulation necessary to implement the provisions of this act on
15 such effective date.
