AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to automated external defibrillators

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 1 of section 3000-b of the 2 public health law, as added by chapter 552 of the laws of 1998, is 3 amended to read as follows:
- (b) "Emergency health care provider" means (i) a physician with knowledge and experience in the delivery of emergency cardiac care; [ex]
 (ii) a physician assistant or nurse practitioner with knowledge and
 experience in the delivery of emergency cardiac care, and who is acting
 within his or her scope of practice; or (iii) a hospital licensed under
 article twenty-eight of this chapter that provides emergency cardiac
 care.
- 11 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 12 it shall have become a law; provided that, effective immediately, the 13 addition, amendment, and/or repeal of any rules and regulations neces-14 sary to implement the provisions of this act on its effective date are 15 authorized and directed to be completed on or before such effective 16 date.
