AN ACT to amend the civil rights law, in relation to prohibiting the involuntary removal from a commercial passenger aircraft of any passenger having an assigned seat thereon, on the basis of overbooking by the operator of such aircraft

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The civil rights law is amended by adding a new section 2 79-o to read as follows:
- § 79-o. Action for involuntary removal from a commercial passenger aircraft; certain cases. 1. No passenger admitted to a commercial passenger aircraft, having paid the fare for transportation on such aircraft and having an assigned seat thereon, shall be involuntarily removed from such aircraft solely on the bases that the owner or operator of the aircraft overbooked the flight thereof or assigned the
- passenger's seat to another individual.

 2. Any person involuntarily removed from a commercial passenger
 aircraft, in violation of subdivision one of this section, may commence
 and maintain a cause of action to recover treble damages, plus costs and

- 14 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
