Introduced by M. of A. PERRY -- read once and referred to the Committee on Transportation

AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to prohibiting the parking of a vehicle greater than sixty inches in height within fifteen feet of an intersection

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision (a) of section 1202 of the vehicle and traffic 2 law is amended by adding a new paragraph 4 to read as follows:
- 4. a. Park a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading merchandise or passengers, within fifteen feet of the nearest intersection where the vehicle parked is greater than sixty inches in height.
- 7 <u>b. Any vehicle parked in violation of this paragraph shall be subject</u>
 8 <u>to penalties set by the local governing body with the power to enact</u>
 9 <u>such sanctions.</u>
- 10 <u>c. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any</u> 11 <u>municipality of this state, acting through its local legislative body,</u>
- 12 is hereby authorized and empowered to adopt and amend local laws, rules
- 13 and ordinances, in accordance with the provisions of this paragraph, in
- 14 order to impose a penalty for violating this paragraph, which may
- 15 include, but not be limited to, the cost of towing the vehicle.
- 16 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
