AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to academic credit for veterans

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "veterans' 2 education through SUNY credits act".
- $\S$  2. The education law is amended by adding a new section 6355 to read 4 as follows:
- § 6355. Expanding veterans' educational opportunities act. 1. For the purposes of this section, "veteran" shall mean a person, male or female, who has served in the active military or naval service of the United States during a war in which the United States engaged, and who has been released from such service otherwise than by dishonorable discharge, or
- 2. The state university of New York's board of trustees shall adopt a
  policy requiring each state university of New York and city university
  of New York, including colleges and community colleges, to award academic credit to a student, who is also a veteran, enrolled in the university, for courses that were part of the student's military training or
  service and that meet the standards of the American Council on Education
- or equivalent standards for awarding the academic credit, if the award
- of academic credit is based upon the university's admission standards.

  Each university shall adopt the necessary rules, regulations, and proce-
- 20 dures to implement the provisions of this section.
- 21 <u>3. No fee, tuition or other charge shall be assessed against a veteran</u>
  22 who qualifies for such credit pursuant to this section.
- § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
