AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to establishing a career and technical education diploma

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 817 to 2 read as follows:
- § 817. Career and technical education pathway to a high school diploma. 1. a. A career and technical education (hereinafter referred to in this section as CTE) pathway to a high school diploma is hereby established. A CTE pathway to a diploma shall:
 - (i) result in a regents or local diploma;

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- 8 <u>(ii) differ from the traditional requirements to a regents or local</u>
 9 <u>diploma with respect to required assessments;</u>
- 10 <u>(iii) be made available to all students, including, but not limited to students with disabilities.</u>
- b. A CTE pathway to a diploma shall be based on curriculum and training designed to provide students with career, trade and technical skills
 and shall demonstrate that the student is ready for a career or trade as
 determined by regulations of the commissioner. A CTE pathway to a diploma shall include, but not be limited to:
- (i) completion of a CTE sequence provided and administered by a business practicing a particular trade or career, by a board of cooperative educational services or any secondary education program approved by the commissioner or by an institution of higher education;

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(ii) completion of work-based learning experiences as provided by the 1 2 approved program; and

(iii) completion of a work-skills employability profile.

- c. For purposes of this section, a career and technical education shall include, but not be limited to, courses of study in the following career fields: agriculture education, business and marketing education, family and consumer sciences education, health occupations education, technical education, technology education, and trade and industrial education.
- 2. The regents, in consultation with trade and professional organiza-11 tions, shall promulgate such regulations as may be necessary to establish the curriculum, assessments and any other criteria that students must achieve to earn a regents or local diploma via a CTE pathway.
- 3. Students who entered high school in the two thousand eighteen--two thousand nineteen school year and thereafter shall be eliqible to earn a 15 diploma via a CTE pathway.

This act shall take effect immediately; provided that effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regu-18 lation necessary for the timely implementation of this act on its effec-19 20 tive date are authorized and directed to be made and completed on or 21 before such effective date.
