AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to establishing a college experience program for students with developmental disabilities

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Each community college shall 47 offer such program to eligible students in accordance with the requ-48 lations prescribed by the state university trustees. 49 b. Such program shall consist of: (i) an academic component related to preparing eligible students for 50 51 practical living and employment and shall include coursework related to such purposes including, but not limited to, courses in cooking, 52 personal finance, health and wellness, interpersonal communications, and 53 54 internships; and
