AN ACT to amend the real property law, in relation to protecting tenants from illegally converted dwellings  $\,$ 

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The real property law is amended by adding a new section 2 235-bb to read as follows:
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  3 § 235-bb. Certificates of occupancy; required disclosure to tenant. 1.
- 4 Prior to executing a residential lease or rental agreement with a
- 5 tenant, the owner of real property consisting of three or fewer rental
- 6 units shall provide conspicuous notice in bold face type as to whether a
- 7 certificate of occupancy, if such certificate is required by law, is
- 8 currently valid for the dwelling unit subject to the lease or rental
  9 agreement. Owners who provide the tenant with an actual copy of the
- 9 agreement. Owners who provide the tenant with an actual copy of the
- valid certificate of occupancy shall be deemed to have complied with the requirements of this subdivision.
- 12 2. Any agreement by a lessee or tenant of premises for dwelling
- 13 purposes waiving or modifying his or her rights as set forth in this
- 14 section shall be void as contrary to public policy.
- 15 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately and apply to all residen-
- 16 tial leases entered into on and after such date.
