AN ACT to amend the real property law, in relation to conflicts of interests for cooperative housing

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The real property law is amended by adding a new article 9-C to read as follows:

Article 9-C

## COOPERATIVE HOUSING

5 Section 341. Annual reports for certain transactions required.

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- § 341. Annual reports for certain transactions required. 1. Every cooperative housing corporation, incorporated pursuant to the not-for-profit corporation law, shall, at least once each year:
- 9 (a) require that each director, as defined in paragraph six of subdi10 vision (a) of section one hundred two of the not-for-profit corporation
  11 law, receive a copy of section seven hundred fifteen of the not-for-pro12 fit corporation law; and
- 13 (b) submit an annual report to the attorney general of the state of
  14 New York, which shall be signed by each such director, containing infor15 mation on any contracts made, entered into, or otherwise voted on by the
  16 board of directors that were subject to section seven hundred fifteen of
  17 the not-for-profit corporation law.
  - 2. Every cooperative housing corporation, incorporated pursuant to the business corporation law, shall, at least once each year:
- 20 (a) require that each director, as defined in paragraph five of subdi-21 vision (a) of section one hundred two of the business corporation law, 22 receive a copy of section seven hundred thirteen of the business corpo-23 ration law; and
- 24 (b) submit an annual report to the attorney general of the state of 25 New York, which shall be signed by each such director, containing infor-

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1 mation on any contracts made, entered into, or otherwise voted on by the 2 board of directors that were subject to section seven hundred thirteen 3 of the business corporation law.

- 3. The annual report required either by paragraph (b) of subdivision one or paragraph (b) of subdivision two of this section shall include, but not be limited to, the following:
- 7 (a) a list of all contracts voted on by the board of directors,
  8 including information on the contract recipient, contract amount, and
  9 the purpose of entering into the contract;
- 10 (b) the record of each meeting including director attendance, voting 11 records for contracts, and how each director voted on such contracts; 12 and
- 13 (c) the date of each vote on each contract, and the date the contract
  14 would be and remain valid.
- 4. If the annual report required either by paragraph (b) of subdivision one or paragraph (b) of subdivision two of this section would,
  notwithstanding the requirements of this section, contain no information
  because of the absence of any actions taken by the board that would
  otherwise qualify for inclusion in such annual report, then the board
  shall instead submit to the attorney general of the state of New York a
  document, signed by each director, indicating: "No actions taken by the
  board were subject to the annual report required pursuant to section 341
  of the Real Property Law".
- § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law.
