AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to the Lt. Cameron N. Hall Memorial Bridge

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 342-ddd of the highway law, as added by a chapter of the laws of 2017, amending the highway law relating to designating a portion of the state highway system in the town of Hancock, county of Delaware as the "Lt. Cameron N. Hall Memorial Bridge", as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 4475-A and A.3913-A, is amended to read as follows:

§ 342-ddd. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the Ut. Cameron N. Hall Memorial Bridge". The bridge on state route nine-ty-seven, designated New York state bridge number [1035450] 1035470, in the town of Hancock, county of Delaware, shall be designated and known as the "Lt. Cameron N. Hall Memorial Bridge".

§ 2. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same manner as a chapter of the laws of 2017, amending the highway law relating to designating a portion of the state highway system in the town of Hancock, county of Delaware as the "Lt. Cameron N. Hall Memorial Bridge", as proposed in legislative bills numbers S.4475-A and A.3913-A, takes effect.
