The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 9 of section 2502 of the education law is 2 REPEALED.

- § 2. Section 2601 of the education law, as amended by chapter 171 of the laws of 1996, is amended to read as follows:
- § 2601. Application of article. This article shall apply to each city 6 school district of a city which has less than one hundred twenty-five thousand inhabitants, according to the latest federal census, except as otherwise provided in section twenty-six hundred one-a of this chapter and except as otherwise provided by subdivision [nine or or or section twenty-five hundred two of this chapter. 10
- § 3. Subdivision 2 of section 2601-a of the education law, as amended by section 9 of part A of chapter 97 of the laws of 2011, is amended to 12 13 read as follows:
- 14 2. The board of education shall conduct all annual and special school 15 district meetings for the purpose of adopting a school district budget 16 in the same manner as a union free school district in accordance with 17 the provisions of article forty-one of this title, except as otherwise 18 provided by this section. The 7 provisions of this article, and where applicable [subdivisions nine and] subdivision nine-a of section twenty-five hundred two of this title, 9 governing the qualification and registration of voters, and procedures 10 for the nomination and election of members of the board of education 11 shall continue to apply, and shall govern the qualification and registration of voters and voting procedures with respect to the adoption of 12 13 a school district budget.

- 2. The board of education shall conduct all annual and special school district meetings for the purpose of adopting a school district budget in the same manner as a union free school district in accordance with 20 the provisions of article forty-one of this title, except as otherwise provided by this section. The annual meeting and election of each such city school district shall be held on the third Tuesday of May in each year, provided, however that such annual meeting and election shall be 23 24 held on the second Tuesday in May if the commissioner at the request of a local school board certifies no later than March first that such election would conflict with religious observances, and any school budget revote shall be held on the date and in the same manner specified in subdivision three of section two thousand seven of this title. The provisions of this article, and where applicable [subdivisions nine and] 30 subdivision nine-a of section twenty-five hundred two of this title, 31 governing the qualification and registration of voters, and procedures for the nomination and election of members of the board of education 33 shall continue to apply, and shall govern the qualification and registration of voters and voting procedures with respect to the adoption of 35 a school district budget.
