AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to including Round lake in the list of inland waterways eligible for the local waterfront revitalization program

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 4 of section 911 of the executive law, as separately amended by chapters 255 and 433 of the laws of
