AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to allowing two automatic free transfers for riders using pay-per-ride Metrocards

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1266 of the public authorities law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 3-b to read as follows:
- 3 3-b. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the authority shall establish a fare transfer policy that may be amended from time to time.
- 5 Such policy shall provide any person who pays a fare or rate with at
- 6 <u>least two transfers at no cost between any subway and bus, or between</u>
- 7 buses that are owned and operated by the authority. Such transfers shall
- 8 be valid for two hours from the time such fare or rate is collected by
- 9 the authority at a transit facility.
- 10 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
