AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to autism screening for children three years of age and under

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Paragraphs (b) and (c) of subdivision 1 of section 2500-j
2 of the public health law, as added by chapter 335 of the laws of 2008,
3 are amended and a new paragraph (d) is added to read as follows:
4 (b) a provider/parental dialogue, utilizing the modified checklist for
5 autism in toddlers as a reference, intended to educate parents in regard
6 to autism spectrum disorders; [~~and~~]
7 (c) an appropriate referral mechanism for children who, based upon
8 results of the aforementioned screening process, require further evalu-
9 ation[~~-~~]; and
10 (d) developmental screenings for children three years of age and youn-
11 ger who are screened under this section. Such screenings shall be in
12 compliance with the periodicity schedule and standardized and validated
13 screening tools that have been established by the Bright
14 Futures/American Academy of Pediatrics Recommendations for Preventative
15 Health Care and any subsequent updates to those recommendations.
16 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall
17 have become a law; provided, however, the amendment and/or repeal of any
18 rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its
19 effective date are authorized and directed to be made and completed on
20 or before such effective date.
