WHEREAS, ACT UP strives for the following: adequate funding or leadership for AIDS research, health care, or housing for people with AIDS; proper advertisement of lifesaving information about safer sex, clean needles, and other AIDS prevention; and nondiscriminatory practices against people who are living with AIDS; and

WHEREAS, It is the sense of this Legislative Body that when organizations of such noble aims and accomplishments are brought to our attention, they should be celebrated and recognized by all the citizens of the great State of New York; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Legislative Body pause in its deliberations to commemorate the 30th Anniversary of AIDS Coalition to Unleash Power; and be it further
