**WHEREAS,** Her effort is exemplified by the 22,000 calls placed by her chapter last year on an important state ballot initiative, and this exists as only the latest testament to her skill and passion; and

**WHEREAS,** Throughout her time as a teacher, she participated in the United Federation of Teachers, acted as a liaison to the Central Labor Council, served as the Manhattan political action coordinator in 1978, and merited no less than five proclamations from Manhattan borough presidents; and

**WHEREAS,** She now participates as the political action coordinator for her chapter of retired teachers, guiding phone bank volunteer recruitment, topic research, and script writing as needed and often exceeding expectation of that which is required; and

**WHEREAS,** This is a well-deserved honor for a woman who has married expertise and passion to better serve New Yorkers her entire working life, while also providing a quality education to students the whole time without fail; now, therefore, be it
