MEMORIALIZING Governor Andrew M. Cuomo to proclaim March 27, 2018, as Nephrotic Syndrome Awareness Day in the State of New York

WHEREAS, NephCure Kidney International has made great strides in accelerating treatments for Nephrotic Syndrome and FSGS patients; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Legislative Body pause in its deliberations to memorialize Governor Andrew M.
