AN ACT to establish the New York city tax reform study commission, and providing for its powers and duties

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby established the New York city tax reform study commission to provide the governor and the legislature with a blueprint for reforming the local real property tax system in the city

§ 2. The New York city tax reform study commission shall consist of 11 members appointed by the governor: three members shall be appointed upon the recommendation of the temporary president of the senate, three members shall be appointed upon the recommendation of the speaker of the assembly, two members shall be appointed upon the recommendation of the 10 mayor of the city of New York, one member shall be appointed upon the recommendation of the speaker of the city council of the city of New York, one member shall be appointed upon the recommendation of the 13 minority leader of the senate, and one member shall be appointed upon 14 the recommendation of the minority leader of the assembly. 1 sion shall include at least one member representative of each of the 2 following: the New York city municipal government, academia, real 3 estate industry and a recognized labor organization, all based in the 4 city of New York.

- § 3. On or before January 1, 2020, the New York city tax reform study commission shall provide the governor and the legislature with recommendations on any changes that should be made to, at a minimum, the class share system, assessment process and tax rate formulae utilized within the city of New York.
- 10 § 4. The New York city tax reform study commission shall be assisted 11 in its powers and duties pursuant to this act by personnel employed by 12 state and city of New York agencies including, but not limited to, the 13 state department of taxation and finance and the department of finance 14 of the city of New York.
- 15 § 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
