AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to designating and nominating petitions

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 6-132 of the election law, as 1 2 amended by chapter 235 of the laws of 2000, is amended to read as 3 follows: 4 1.
