- AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to expanding the definition of aggravated cruelty to animals to include harm to animals during the commission of a felony

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Kirby and
 Quigley's Law."
 § 2. Subdivision 1 of section 353-a of the agriculture and markets

4 law, as added by chapter 118 of the laws of 1999, is amended to read as 5 follows:

1. A person is guilty of aggravated cruelty to animals when[¬]: either
(a) with no justifiable purpose, he or she intentionally kills or
intentionally causes serious physical injury , as defined in subdivision
<u>twenty-nine of section one hundred eight of this chapter</u>, to a companion
animal with aggravated cruelty[¬]; or

(b) in the course of commission of a felony, or of immediate flight therefrom, he or she causes intentional physical injury, as defined in subdivision twenty-eight of section one hundred eight of this chapter, or death to a companion animal.

For purposes of this section, "aggravated cruelty" shall mean conduct which: (i) is intended to cause extreme physical pain; or (ii) is done or carried out in an especially depraved or sadistic manner.

18 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
