AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to immunization reports by pharmacies

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 6801 of the education law, as  
2 added by chapter 563 of the laws of 2008, is amended to read as follows:

3 3. No pharmacist shall administer immunizing agents without receiving  
4 training satisfactory to the commissioner and the commissioner of health  
5 which shall include, but not be limited to, techniques for screening  
6 individuals and obtaining informed consent; techniques of adminis-  
7 tration; indications, precautions and contraindications in the use of  
8 agent or agents; record keeping of immunization and information; and  
9 handling emergencies, including anaphylaxis and needlesticks. Within  
10 thirty days of administering an immunizing agent, a pharmacist shall  
11 furnish documentation of such immunization to the primary care physician  
12 of a person receiving such immunization.

13 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that  
14 the amendments to subdivision 3 of section 6801 of the education law  
15 made by section one of this act shall not affect the expiration of such  
16 section and shall be deemed to expire therewith.
