AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "North Country Craft Beer Trails"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-h to 2 read as follows:

§ 344-h. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the "North Country Craft Beer Trails". All that portion of the state highway system constituting route 3 from country road 75 in Sackets Harbor, I-81 in Watertown until exit 48, I-781 until exit 4, and US 11 until NY-68 in Canton, shall be designated and known as the "North Country Craft Beer Trails".

§ 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the designation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be changed as a result of this act.
