AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to designating the $\,$ month of May as Korean American Family Month

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 168-b 2 to read as follows:
- § 168-b. Designation of months of commemoration. 1. A month of commemoration is a calendar month so designated by this section or a calendar month in any one year so designated by a proclamation of the governor or resolution of the senate and assembly jointly adopted.
- 7 2. A month of commemoration shall not constitute a holiday or half-ho-8 liday but shall be a month set aside in recognition and special honor of 9 a person, persons, group, ideal or goal.
- 3. The following month shall be a month of commemoration in each year:
 11 May, to be known as "Korean American Family Month".
- 12 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-13 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
