AN ACT to amend the town law, in relation to absentee ballots for fire district elections

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 175-b of the town law, as amended by chapter 401 of the laws of 1996, is amended to read as follows:

1. The board of fire commissioners of any fire district in which officers are elected, [may] shall, by resolution, provide for absentee ballots for fire district elections, in accordance with the provisions of this section. Such resolution shall take effect at the first such

election held more than sixty days after its adoption [and shall continue in effect for all such elections until a subsequent resolution providing otherwise shall, in like manner, have taken effect].

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
