AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to performance of illegal maneuvers while operating a motorcycle

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new 2 section 1254 to read as follows:

§ 1254. Performance of an illegal maneuver while operating a motorcy-4 cle. (a) "Illegal maneuver" shall mean any maneuver performed by the operator of a motorcycle which requires the front or rear wheel of such motorcycle to leave contact with the road, or any maneuver described in subdivisions (b) and (c) of section twelve hundred fifty-two of this article. Illegal maneuver shall not mean a maneuver performed by a motorcycle with a side passenger truck attachment, in which the side truck leaves the road in the course of taking a turn.

(b) An operator of a motorcycle that performs an illegal maneuver that results in property damage or bodily harm of another shall be punishable 12 by a fine not to exceed twenty-five hundred dollars and the automatic 14 revocation of the operator's license and registration for a period of 15 <u>one year.</u>

(c) An operator of a motorcycle that performs an illegal maneuver that 16 17 results in property damage or bodily harm of another within eighteen months of a prior conviction where the violator performed an illegal 18 19 maneuver that resulted in property damage or bodily harm of another, 20 shall be punishable by the forfeiture of the operator's motorcycle and 21 the automatic revocation of the operator's license and registration for 22 <u>a period of two years.</u>

1 part B of chapter 55 of the laws of 2014, are amended and two new subparagraphs (xiv) and (xv) are added to read as follows:

(xii) of a second or subsequent conviction of a violation of section 4 twelve hundred twenty-five-c or section twelve hundred twenty-five-d of this chapter committed where such person is the holder of a probationary license, as defined in subdivision four of section five hundred one of this title, at the time of the commission of such violation and such second or subsequent violation was committed within six months following the restoration or issuance of such probationary license; [ex]

(xiii) of a second or subsequent conviction of a violation of section 11 twelve hundred twenty-five-c or section twelve hundred twenty-five-d of this chapter committed where such person is the holder of a class DJ or 13 MJ learner's permit or a class DJ or MJ license at the time of the 14 commission of such violation and such second or subsequent violation was committed within six months following the restoration of such permit or license[-];

(xiv) of a violation of subdivision (b) of section twelve hundred 17 fifty-four of this chapter shall result in a license and registration 18 19 revocation of one year; or

20 (xv) of a second violation of subdivision (b) of section twelve 21 hundred fifty-four of this chapter shall result in a license and regis-22 <u>tration revocation of two years.</u>

23 § 3. This act shall take effect on the one hundred sixtieth day after 24 it shall have become a law.
