AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to publication of candidates to be voted upon at an election

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 4-122 of the election law, as 2 amended by chapter 359 of the laws of 1989, is amended to read as 3 follows:
- 1. The county board of elections shall publish, at least six days before an election, a list containing the name [and residence] of every candidate for public office to be voted for within its jurisdiction at such election.
- 8 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
