The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Laree's Law."
- 2 § 2. Subdivision 4 of section 125.20 of the penal law, as added by 3 chapter 477 of the laws of 1990, is amended and a new subdivision 5 is 4 added to read as follows:
 - 4. Being eighteen years old or more and with intent to cause physical injury to a person less than eleven years old, the defendant recklessly engages in conduct which creates a grave risk of serious physical injury to such person and thereby causes the death of such person[-]; or
- 9 <u>5. He intentionally and unlawfully sells an opioid analgesic and the</u> 10 <u>ingestion of such opioid analgesic causes the death of another person.</u>
