AN ACT to amend the parks, recreation and historic preservation law, in relation to prohibiting littering on state park lands

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The parks, recreation and historic preservation law is 2 amended by adding a new section 13.12 to read as follows:
- § 13.12 Throwing refuse on park lands prohibited. 1. No person shall throw, dump, deposit or place, or cause to be thrown, dumped, deposited or placed upon any park lands or upon private lands adjacent thereto, any refuse, trash, garbage, rubbish, litter or any nauseous or offensive matter.
- 8 2. Nothing herein contained shall be construed as prohibited the use
 9 in a reasonable manner as ashes, sand, salt or other material for the
 10 purpose of reducing the hazard of, or providing traction on snow, ice or
 11 sleet.
- 3. A violation of the provisions of subdivision one of this section
 shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed seven hundred fifty dollars
 and/or a requirement to perform services at the park lands where the
 offense occurred, or, in the discretion of the department, at another
 state park land location, not to exceed ten hours and for any second or
 subsequent violation by a fine not to exceed one thousand four hundred
 dollars and/or a requirement to perform services at the park lands where
 the offense occurred, or, in the discretion of the department, at anoth-
