AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to providing grant assistance for service dogs

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 303-a of the social services law is renumbered subdivision 5 and a new subdivision 4 is added to read as follows:

4 <u>4. If such service dog is deemed medically necessary by a licensed</u> 5 <u>physician, grant assistance shall be provided for up to five thousand</u>

6 dollars for the purchase and training, food, and any other expense

7 required for the health or maintenance of such service dog.

8 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
