AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to interference with a funeral procession

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new 2 section 1132 to read as follows:

§ 1132. Interference with a funeral procession. (a) The driver of a 4 motor vehicle shall not enter, drive between, obstruct, hinder or in any way interfere with the vehicles constituting a funeral procession while such vehicles are in motion unless such motor vehicle is part of such procession, except when authorized to do so by a police officer or when such motor vehicle is an authorized emergency vehicle exhibiting a visible signal and sounding an audible signal or when complying with the provisions of section eleven hundred forty-four-a of this title.

(b) Any person operating a motor vehicle in violation of subdivision (a) of this section shall be guilty of a traffic infraction and subject to a fine of not more than fifty dollars. The commissioner shall not assess any points against the license of a person found to have violated the provisions of subdivision (a) of this section.

(c) No provision of this section shall be deemed to impose any liabil-17 ity for personal injury or damages resulting from a violation of this section upon a funeral firm or any person licensed or registered pursuant to article thirty-four of the public health law, or any employee or 19 20 agent thereof, when such firm, person, employee or agent is acting with-21 in the scope of his, her or its duties. However, any funeral firm or 22 any person licensed or registered pursuant to article thirty-four of the 23 public health law, or any employee or agent thereof, shall at all times operate motor vehicles in compliance with all standards of care imposed
