AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system in the town of Islip, county of Suffolk, as the "Specialist Matthew E. Baylis Memorial Bridge"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-f to 2 read as follows:

§ 344-f. Portion of state highway system to be designated as the "Specialist Matthew E. Baylis Memorial Bridge". The bridge on Oakdale-Bohemia Road, exit number 47A over route 27 in the town of Islip, county of Suffolk, shall be designated and known as the "Specialist Matthew E. Baylis Memorial Bridge".

- § 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid 10 11 confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-12 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of 13 ceremonial nature and the official name of such bridge shall not be 14 changed as a result of this act.
- § 3. This act shall take effect immediately. 15
