AN ACT to remove from the Albert Wisner memorial public library service area that portion of the town of Chester, in the county of Orange, which is located within such district

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the terms of the resolution, enacted pursuant to section 255 of the education law, establishing the Albert Wisner memorial public library in 1973 or the charter issued in 1979 for such library by the board of regents, pursuant to section 216 of the education law, no real property in the town of Chester, in the county of Orange, shall be deemed to be within the service area of such public library. Under no circumstance shall the Warwick Valley central school district impose any library tax for the support of the Albert Wisner memorial public library upon any parcel of real property in the town of Chester. For all purposes, any real property removed from the service area of the Albert Wisner memorial public library pursuant to this act shall be deemed to be within the service area of the Chester public library and shall be subject to taxation for the support of the Chester public library.

15 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of July next succeeding 16 the date on which it shall have become a law.
