AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to expanding the offense of assault in the second degree to include the infliction of physical injury to employees of domestic violence shelters and persons seeking shelter in such shelters

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 120.05 of the penal law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 3-d to read as follows:

3-d. (a) With intent to prevent an employee of domestic violence shel-4 ters from performing his or her lawful duties while located on the grounds, real property, or a building owned, managed, or operated by such domestic violence shelters or within five hundred feet of such shelters, he or she causes physical injury to such employee; and

(b) with intent to prevent persons seeking services from such domestic 9 violence shelters and/or residing in such shelters from accessing the 10 grounds, real property, or a building owned, managed, or operated by such domestic violence shelters or within five hundred feet of such
