AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to state aid for special education services for a child with a disability

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 4411 2 to read as follows:

- § 4411. State aid for special education services for a child with a 4 disability. 1. On and after July first, two thousand seventeen, the 5 commissioner shall make payments, without apportionment, to school 6 districts and municipalities for special education services for a child with a disability. The full amount of costs directly related to the special education services rendered to such children shall be reim-9 bursed, provided that any placement of such children were approved by 10 the commissioner.
- 11 2. Any moneys due to a municipality or school district shall be 12 reduced by the amount of any federal participation, pursuant to title 13 XIX of the social security act, in special education programs provided 14 pursuant to this article.
- 15 3. Whenever the state aid provided pursuant to this section creates a 16 budgetary surplus for a school district or municipality, such surplus 17 shall be utilized solely to reduce taxes for the following fiscal year.
- 18 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
