AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to grand larceny in the fourth degree and criminal possession of stolen property in the fourth degree of metal wire used as a conductor to transmit and distribute electrical energy

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 155.30 of the penal law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 12 to read as follows:
- 12. The property consists of metal wire which is owned by an electric company or public utility operated by a municipality or district and which functions as a conductor to transmit and distribute electrical energy in the electrical grid.
  - § 2. Section 165.45 of the penal law is amended by adding a new subdivision 8 to read as follows:
- 9 8. The property consists of metal wire which is owned by an electric company or public utility operated by a municipality or district and which functions as a conductor to transmit and distribute electrical energy in the electrical grid.
- 13 § 3. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 14 have become a law.
