AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to tinting on motor vehicles

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 16 of section 206 of the public health law, as added by chapter 135 of the laws of 1994, is amended to read as follows:

16. The commissioner, in consultation with the commissioner of the department of motor vehicles, shall promulgate rules and regulations specifying the medical conditions based on health and safety which justify granting an exception to the requirements of subparagraphs one and two of paragraph (b) of subdivision twelve-a of section three hundred seventy-five of the vehicle and traffic law. Such medical conditions, shall include, but not be limited to, polymorphous light eruption, porphyia, xeroderma pigmentosa, and severe drug photo-sensitivity.

12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
