AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to designating sheriffs, under-sheriffs and deputy sheriffs of the city of New York as police officers

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 34 of section 1.20 of the 2 criminal procedure law is amended to read as follows:
 - (b) Sheriffs, under-sheriffs and deputy sheriffs [of gounties outside of New York City];
 - § 2. Subdivision 2 of section 2.10 of the criminal procedure law, as amended by chapter 969 of the laws of 1983, is amended to read as follows;
- 2. [The sheriff, undersheriff and deputy sheriffs of New York city and sworn] Sworn officers of the Westchester county department of public safety services appointed after January thirty-first, nineteen hundred eighty-three to the title of public safety officer and who perform the functions previously performed by a Westchester county deputy sheriff on or prior to such date.
