The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The social services law is amended by adding a new section
110-b to read as follows:
§ 110-b. Recovery from a person discovered to have property; notice.
Notwithstanding any law, rule or regulation to the contrary, an appli cant for public assistance shall be fully informed in writing that he or
she may be liable to reimburse the state for public assistance benefits
received, as provided for in this title. Notice may be given as part of

8 an informational booklet promulgated by the office of temporary and

9 disability services and as a standalone document on his or her rights

10 and responsibilities. Nothing in this section shall be deemed to

11 prevent the local social services district from maintaining its records 12 electronically.
