AN ACT to amend the domestic relations law, in relation to adoption by a petitioner where such petitioner's parentage is legally-recognized

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 110 of the domestic relations law is amended by 2 adding a new closing paragraph to read as follows:

A petition to adopt, pursuant to the terms of this article, where the petitioner's parentage is legally-recognized under New York State law shall not be denied solely on the basis that the petitioner's parentage is already legally-recognized.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
