AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to issuing non-certified copies of original long form birth certificates to adoptees

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 4174 of the public health law is amended by adding a new subdivision 10 to read as follows:
- 10.(a) The commissioner, or any person authorized by him or her, shall issue non-certified copies of original long form birth certificates upon specific request therefor by an adoptee, if eighteen years of age or more, or if the adoptee is deceased, by the adoptee's descendants, or by other lawful representatives of such adoptee, to whom the record of birth relates including authorized representatives of a local social services district if the adoptee is in the care and custody or custody and quardianship of such district.
- 11 (b) The commissioner shall issue a non-certified copy of the original long form birth certificate within forty-five days after receipt of such
- 13 request.
- 14 (c) The department shall develop policies and procedures necessary to 15 implement this subdivision by February first, two thousand eighteen.
- 16 (d) The department may charge a fee for issuing such non-certified 17 copy of an original long form birth certificate. The fee may not exceed 18 the fee for a certified copy of an original long form birth certificate
- 19 <u>as provided for in subdivision two of this section.</u>
 20 § 2. This act shall take effect August 1, 2017.
