FELDER -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Transportation -- reported favorably from said committee, ordered to first and second report, ordered to a third reading, amended and ordered reprinted, retaining its place in the order of third reading

AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to directing the department of transportation to establish a maximum speed limit of thirty-five miles per hour on state route 908H, better known as "Ocean parkway", in the county of Kings

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 1620 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new subdivision (a-1) to read as follows:
- (a-1) Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision (a) of this section or any other provision of law authorizing cities having a population of one million or more to establish maximum speed limits on state highways, the department of transportation shall establish a maximum speed limit of thirty-five miles per hour on state route nine hundred eight H, better known as "Ocean parkway", in the county of Kings.
- 9 § 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 10 have become a law.
