AN ACT to amend the New York State urban development corporation act, in relation to the incubator program

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subdivision 2 of section 16-v of section 1 2 of chapter 174 of the laws of 1968, constituting the New York State 3 urban development corporation act, as added by section 1 of part C of 4 chapter 59 of the laws of 2013, is amended to read as follows:

5 (c) The corporation, subject to appropriations provided for this 6 purpose, may approve and designate [five] ten New York state incubator 7 hot spots [in fiscal year two thousand thirteen-two thousand fourteen 8 and five additional New York state innovation hot spots in fiscal year 9 two thousand fourteen-two thousand fifteen]. Such designees will be 10 required to demonstrate an affiliation with and the application support

11 of at least one college, university or independent research institution, 12 and that its programs and purposes are consistent with regional economic 13 development strategies.

14 § 2. Paragraph (c) of subdivision 5 of section 16-v of section 1 of 15 chapter 174 of the laws of 1968, constituting the New York State urban 16 development corporation act, as added by section 1 of part C of chapter 17 59 of the laws of 2013, is amended to read as follows:

(c) No deduction. In addition to the foregoing requirements, an incubator sponsor shall agree to dedicate all funds from any grants or support received pursuant to this subdivision to the operations of the incubator without deductions for [everhead,] indirect costs[, or facilities and administration charges] of such sponsor.

1 § 3. Subdivision 6 of section 16-v of section 1 of chapter 174 of the 2 laws of 1968, constituting the New York State urban development corpo-3 ration act, as added by section 1 of part C of chapter 59 of the laws of 4 2013, is amended to read as follows:

5 6. Other assistance. The corporation [shall] may make such other aid, б assistance, and resources available to New York state innovation hot 7 spots and New York state incubators and their clients as it shall deem 8 useful and appropriate for the furtherance of the purposes of this act, 9 including without limitation technical assistance, aid in marketing, aid 10 in reaching and providing entrepreneurship training opportunities to 11 such marginalized groups as those composed of individuals who are minority, female, disabled, or poor, and others, curriculum development, and 12 other services and resources. The corporation shall also seek assistance 13 14 from other state agencies in the development of procurement and market-15 ing resources and training opportunities for New York state innovation 16 hot spots and New York state incubators and their clients.

17 § 4. Subdivision 8 of section 16-v of section 1 of chapter 174 of the 18 laws of 1968, constituting the New York state urban development corpo-19 ration act, as added by section 1 of part C of chapter 59 of the laws of 20 2013, is amended to read as follows:

21 8. New York state innovation hot spots may certify clients which meet 22 the requirements of subdivision nine of this section as qualified entities eligible for New York state innovation hot spot program tax bene-23 24 fits pursuant to section thirty-eight of the tax law. [Under no circum-25 stance may business enterprises of incubators designated as New York 26 state incubators under paragraph (b) of subdivision one of this section 27 be eligible for tax benefits under section thirty-eight of the tax law] 28 Business enterprises of incubators designed as New York state incubators 29 under paragraph (a) of subdivision one of this section may be certified 30 by the New York state innovation hot spot if the incubator has entered 31 into a memoranda of understanding with a hot spot establishing a process 32 and threshold or the hot spot is providing services or assistance to the 33 business enterprise in addition to those provided by the incubator. 34 § 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
