AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to prohibiting a child from being left unattended in a motor vehicle under conditions presenting substantial risk

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

## Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new section 1210-a to read as follows: § 1210-a. Unattended child in a motor vehicle. No parent, guardian or other person legally charged with the care or custody of a child less than sixteen years old shall knowingly or recklessly, under conditions that present a substantial health or safety risk, leave such child unat tended inside a motor vehicle. Nothing in this section shall be deemed to supersede the provisions of any other applicable section of law. § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
