AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to excluding outpatient blood clotting factor products and related services and treatments from coverage by managed care provided to medical assistance recipients

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 364-j of the social services law 2 is amended by adding a new paragraph (d-3) to read as follows:

(d-3) Outpatient blood clotting factor products, and other treatments and services furnished in connection with the care of hemophilia and other blood clotting protein deficiencies shall not be provided to medical assistance recipients through managed care programs established pursuant to this section, and shall continue to be provided outside of managed care programs and in accordance with applicable reimbursement 9 <u>methodologies</u>.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that 10 11 the amendments to subdivision 3 of section 364-j of the social services 12 law made by section one of this act shall not affect the repeal of such 13 subdivision and shall be deemed to repeal therewith.
