AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to designating certain opiates as schedule I and II substances; and to repeal certain provisions of such law relating thereto

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Subdivision (b) of schedule I of section 3306 of the public 2 health law is amended by adding five new paragraphs 56, 57, 58, 60 to read as follows:
- (56) N-(1-phenethylpiperdin-4-yl)-N-phenylfuran-2-carboxamide (Furanyl 5 Fentanyl).
- 6 (57) N-phenyl-N-{1-(2-phenylethyl)-4-piperidinyl}-pentanamide (Valeryl 7 Fentanyl, Pentanyl, Pentanyl, Pentanyl).
- (58) U-47700(3,4-dichloro-N-(2-(dimethylamino)cyclohexyl)-N-methyl-ben-9 <u>zamide)yl.</u>
- (59) 4-chloro-N-{1-{2-(4-nitrophenyl)ethyl}-2-piperidinylidene}-benzene-10 11 <u>sulfonamide (W18).</u>
- 12 (60) Carfentanil.

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- 13 § 2. Subdivision (c) of schedule II of section 3306 of the public 14 health law is amended by adding a new paragraph 29 to read as follows:
- (29) 4-(methoxycarbonyl)-4-(N-phenmethoxyacetamido)-1-{2-(thienyl)
- 16 ethyl}piperidine(Thiafentanil).
- § 3. Paragraph 6 of subdivision (c) of schedule II of section 3306 of 17 the public health law is REPEALED. 18
- 19 § 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
