AN ACT authorizing any special district in the county of Nassau to change the date of the election for the year two thousand seventeen

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 211 of the town law, in the county of Nassau, in the year two thousand seventeen any special district may, by local option, move the special district election from the second Tuesday in December to Tuesday, December fifth. § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
