AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to prohibiting child sex offenders from possessing a depiction of any minor during their incarceration

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 70.80 of the penal law is amended by adding a new subdivision 10 to read as follows:
- 10. Every sentence for a sex offense, as defined in subdivision two or
 three of section one hundred sixty-eight-a of the correction law,
 imposed pursuant to any section of this article, where the victim of
 such offense was a minor, shall include as a part thereof a prohibition
 against the possession of photographs, videos or any other depictions of
 any minor during the term of such incarceration.
- 9 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-10 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
