AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to certain motorcyclists from requirements to wear protective helmets

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 6 of section 381 of the vehicle and traffic 2 law, as amended by chapter 471 of the laws of 1994, is amended to read 3 as follows:

6. It shall be unlawful for any person <u>under the age of twenty-one</u> to operate or ride upon a motorcycle unless he <u>or she</u> wears a protective helmet of a type which meets the requirements set forth in section 571.218 of the federal motor vehicle safety standards as may from time to time be amended. The commissioner is hereby authorized and directed to adopt regulations for helmets which are consistent with the requirements as specified in section 571.218 of the federal motor vehicle safety standards as may from time to time be amended. The police authorities of a city, town or village may issue a permit exempting members of organizations sponsoring or conducting parades or other public exhibitions from the provisions of this subdivision while such members are participating in such parades or other public exhibitions.

16 § 2. This act shall take effect on the forty-fifth day after it shall 17 have become a law.
